- Cyrus Rules Persian Worldwide Empire
- Darius Appointed Ruler Of Babylon
- Daniel (80–82) Promoted By Darius
- First Jews Return To Jerusalem – Ezra 1:1-4

### 4 Keys To Finishing Well

- 1. We never retire from God's calling on our lives.** - 2 Tim. 4:6-8
  - Daniel's example to follow
  - Myths we must refuse to follow
- 2. Our private worship is the "secret" to our public impact.** - Mark 1:35
- 3. We never see the power of God's faithfulness until we exercise faith.** - Hebrews 11:6
- 4. Seniors will play a major role in God preparing His children for the next millennium.** - Proverbs 17:6
